Windermere Foundation Fact Sheet

At Windermere, we understand the importance of family and giving back to the communities in which we live and serve. That's why we created the Windermere Foundation, which has supported low-income and homeless families throughout the western U.S. for over two decades. The generous donations of Windermere associates and public supporters have allowed us to provide more than \$38 million to hundreds of services and organizations that support those who need our help most.

Non-profit agencies receiving Windermere Foundation dollars have furnished emergency and transitional housing, as well as subsidized costs for services, such as employment-related counseling, placement, and training. A significant portion of Windermere Foundation dollars also go towards funding programs that help children, including daycare services, literacy programs, summer camps, and providing basic necessities, such as school supplies and backpacks.

Community Service Philosophy:

Windermere is committed to actively enriching the communities in which it serves, and to fighting homelessness.

Windermere Foundation Mission:

The Windermere Foundation, a 501(C) (3) nonprofit organization, was created with the purpose of raising and distributing funds to support homeless assistance programs. Since its beginning in 1989, millions of dollars have been raised to provide shelter, clothing, food and other services to homeless and low-income families. The Foundation addresses the needs of not only families who are already homeless, but of those who are perilously close to becoming homeless—prevention and providing hope are the ultimate goals.

Windermere Foundation Funding:

The Windermere Foundation is funded primarily through the generosity of Windermere agents, staff, and owners. Every time a home is purchased or sold using a Windermere agent, a portion of the commission is donated to the Windermere Foundation. To date, the Windermere Foundation has raised more than \$50 million for programs and organizations that provide services to low-income and homeless families.

Distribution of Funds:

One of the goals of the Windermere Foundation is to keep administrative costs to a minimum so that the vast majority of the funds can be used to support low-income and homeless families. Due to the dedication and generosity of Windermere agents, staff, and owners, less than three percent of Windermere Foundation funds are used to finance administrative costs.
